- 6. If I can come myself, the attendance sheets are with me. If I cannot come, I will arrange another faculty member (whom may be Dr. Ahmed Abukmail, the chair of the Computer Science program and the coordinator of CS colloquia.)
- 7. If you will be more than 10 minutes late, please do not come at all.
- 8. To encourage you asking questions, if you ask a question during the question and answer session of a colloquium, you will be awarded an extra 0.5 points. To get the award, ask the question and send me an email with information about the colloquium, the question you asked, and a brief summary of the answer the speaker provides within two days.
