Make sure that you use *UHCL email address* in your communications with the TA and me. Email addresses other than UHCL's may be filtered by UHCL spam filter.



MS Access Query



UHCL Computer Lab has MS Office installed. It includes Access. Microsoft has a <u>four years license</u> for students on Office 365 University at \$79.99.


(a) Provide the names, regions, and GNP (in millions) of countries in which GNP is greater than 1,000,000 (millions). Display the result in descending order of GNP.




(2) List the names of Asian countries, their GPA and life expectancies. Only list countries with a life expectancy of 75 or above. The result is displayed in the descending order of life expectancy.



(3) List the city names and country names and city populations of cities with a population between 5 and 10 millions. The result is displayed in the descending order of city populations.






(5) List the city names, country names, and populations of cities in which English is an official language of the country. Include only cities with 4 million or more population.
